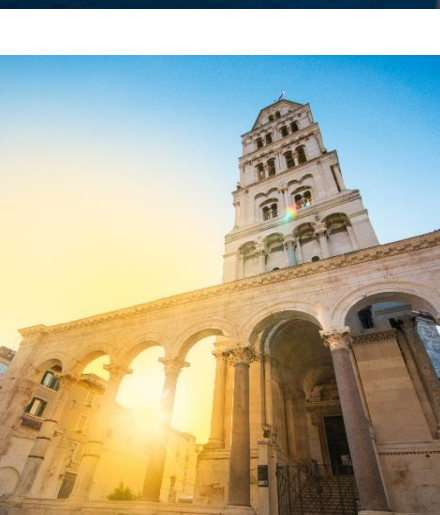
Cruise & Yoga



Our yoga cruise offers specially adjusted daily programs for achieving a perfect balance between your mind, spirit and nature. Get away from the busy world we know and take the opportunity to unwind here in the Croatian Adriatic. Spend an unforgettable week cruising along the Croatian coast from one island to another combined with healthy, fresh meals, different exercises, meditation and aqua yoga in the clear blue sea. The program is designed for beginners as well as those who practice yoga in their everyday life.

Cruising with motor ships along the magnificent Dalmatian coastline & islands on the route:
SPLIT – OMIŠ/PUČIŠĆA – KORČULA – LASTOVO – RAVNIK (Green cave) / KOMIŽA/VIS – BIŠEVO (Blue Cave) /
STARI GRAD – BOL – ŠOLTA - SPLIT





SATURDAY SPLIT – OMIŠ – PUČIŠĆA

Departure from Split at 13:00h followed by lunch on board and a swim break. Late arrivals can join in Omiš. We continue to Pučišća on Brač island. Time to get acquainted with your yoga teacher and fellow passengers at the first meditation session. Pučišća is a typical pretty, Mediterranean village, situated on the northern side of the Brač island at the bottom of the deep bay. It is the cradle of the world's famous white stone of Brač. Possibility of visiting a stone-masonry workshop, one of the few stone masonry workshops left in Europe. Enjoy the domestic food, wine and famous olive oil of this coastal village. Overnight in the port of Pučišća.

SUNDAY PUČIŠĆA – KORČULA

Early morning exercise on the sundeck, followed by breakfast. After a morning swim in the crystal blue sea, we cruise towards Korčula island, the birthplace of explorer, Marco Polo. Lunch will be served either on the tip of the Pelješac peninsula (near Lovište) or in the quiet bay of Kneža on Korčula island. There is afternoon meditation on board in one of the tranquil bays. Late afternoon arrival in Korčula Town for guided sightseeing of this exceptional town. According to legend Korčula was found by Trojan hero Anthenor in the 12th century B.C. This island has more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else in the region. In the evening we recommend a visit to one of numerous konobas(bistro style restaurants) or enjoy the stunning views of the mainland from the numerous cafes and bars. You can also visit a nearby village for a typical village dinner experience. Overnight in Korčula.

MONDAY KORČULA – LASTOVO

As the early morning sun warms you during your Yoga session on the vessel's sun deck, our cruise continues towards the Nature Park on Lastovo, the furthest inhabited island in Dalmatia, which Romans called the Imperial island. Docked in Ubli port, there's an opportunity to visit the protected Nature Park or visit the biggest town on the island – Lastovo itself. The island is surrounded by many smaller islands, with plenty of secluded bays suitable for snorkeling, or if you prefer, some personal meditation. It is also well known for many little churches and the unusually shaped chimneys. This evening is Captain's dinner party on board and overnight.

TUESDAY LASTOVO – RAVNIK (GREEN CAVE) – KOMIŽA / VIS

Enjoy your early morning yoga during departure towards Vis island, which was closed to tourists for many years until fairly recently. Because of its unique geographical position, Vis was a strategic harbour for the navy. Due to this isolation, Vis has a special, time-warp charm of the 'Mediterranean as it once was' which makes it really interesting. Near Vis, there is tiny Ravnik island, where the Green cave is situated. It is named after the unusual light that reflects in the sea from the hole on the top of the cave. After a short swim, depending on the weather conditions, we sail further to the town of Komiža for overnight. Before arrival, there's time to get in touch with your inner self through meditation on the sun deck. Komiža is a typical Mediterranean place on the western part of the island, where the fishing industry on the eastern part of the Adriatic coast began. Enjoy the walk through the narrow alleys and rich heritage, or maybe on one of the pebble beaches with fresh water springs, that stretch along the whole eastern side of the Komiža bay.

WEDNESDAY KOMIŽA/VIS – BIŠEVO (BLUE/GREEN CAVE) – STARI GRAD

Enjoy your early morning Yoga session as we cruise towards the little island of Biševo to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. Sometimes weather conditions here can be very unpredictable, so the possibility of our visit will depend on those conditions and the captain's decision, and you will be notified of this by the crew. Entrance to Blue or Green Cave is to be paid direct on the spot (approx. EUR 14.- per person). We continue towards Stari Grad on Hvar island, officially the sunniest Adriatic island. Afternoon at leisure to explore this unique town after we end our afternoon meditation. The famous Stari Grad Field is the oldest in Croatia and the best preserved example of ancient Greek system of agriculture. Together with the old town it is a part of world heritage protected by UNESCO.

THURSDAY STARI GRAD - BOL

Awake your body and mind with early morning yoga on the sun deck. After breakfast, we cruise towards the beautiful island of Brač and the famous small town of Bol. Swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Zlatni Rat (the Golden Horn - its shingle promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change in shape). We will search for a perfect spot for meditation on Bol (possibly under pines), a typical fishermen's town converted to a popular tourist destination. Here we spend the night and have the opportunity to enjoy excellent fresh fish, local wines and other delicacies of this unique island, enjoy a lovely walk or cycle along the promenade. Hike or rent a scooter up to Vidova Gora for a spectacular view of Bol and surrounding islands.

FRIDAY BOL – ŠOLTA

On our last day we cruise towards the beautiful island of Šolta, well known for its excellent, dark olive oil and lovely little fisherman ports. We spend the night in one of these fishing villages and have the opportunity to enjoy peace and tranquility of this unique island yet which is within sight of Split.

SATURDAY ŠOLTA - SPLIT

Early departure towards Split and time to say goodbye to the crew and all your new friends.

In such cases clients need to take special care when crossing and do this at their own risk. Crew assistance will be given to those needing and requesting it. **Cruise not recommended for clients in wheelchairs or with limited mobility.** Katarina Line and the captain of the vessel reserve the right to change and modify the route due to weather conditions as well as conditions in the ports visited.
